All About Cloth

The right pool table cloth is integral to both the playability of the table and the decor of your game room.

Don't underestimate the importance of your cloth selection, it affects performance.

If you want to play better, your cloth has to be better.



Lighting

Lighting your pool table is the second most important purchase after the pool table. There must be enough bright light over the table to see the entire playing surface without shadows. If the room is too dark, the players eyes might get tired as well.

Choosing and hanging the right lighting

Ambient room light isn't sufficient to light a pool table. You'll see your own shadow on the table.

Game Room Furniture

When you set up your living room, you don't just put in a couch and call it a day. Your game room deserves the same attention! Your family and friends need a place to sit between shots, or just watch the fun. Game room furniture you can add includes chairs, tables, benches and cue racks. And do you really want your dog or cat to be able to jump on the table and potentially rip the cloth with their claws?

Billiard Balls

If you're just shooting around with family and friends for fun, our basic pool ball sets will be just fine. But if you are serious

about your billiards game, we recommend upgrading to billiard balls made of phenolic resin. We carry two sets: the Aramith Premium Ball Set, and the Brunswick Centennial Ball Set.

Standard cloth is included with any table we sell and is intended for recreational play. The cloth is susceptible to spills and stains. Since pilling will occur over time, standard cloth will need occasional brushing to remove the fuzz/loose fibers.

The next step up is cloth that is soaked in Teflon™ solution (vs. just sprayed on top) that makes it resistant to spills and stains. If a spill does occur, the liquid beads up, so it's much easier to clean up.

This cloth also needs regular brushing to remove fuzz/loose fibers.



Questions to Ask When Buying a Pool Table

Lights

Buying a pool table is a big investment, and there are several questions you need to ask to ensure you get the right table that will both fit your space and best match the people who will be playing on it.

How Much Space Do You Have?

Furniture

It's important you fit the table to the room size, and not try to get the room to accommodate the table size you've decided upon. Read our Recommendations for Pool Table Room Size.

Who Will Be Playing on the Table?

The people playing on the table will influence the size you should get.

- The whole family: A 7- or 8-foot table is the best choice. If you have the space, get an 8-foot table.
- Children and friends: Get a 7-foot table. A smaller table is easier to play on for smaller people. On a smaller table, the shooting distance is shorter, and it's easier to get shots into pockets. Also consider getting shorter cues for the kids (48" or 52").
- Adults: Get an 8- or 9- foot table. Keep in mind that a 9-foot table can be more challenging to play on (but that can be a good thing!)

What's the Skill Level of the Players?

- Beginners and casual players: Lean towards smaller tables to achieve more success and enjoyment. You don't have to make shots to have fun, but on smaller tables, the ratio of pocket size to table size is bigger, and it's easier to make shots!
- Competitive experienced players: Get the largest table your space can accommodate. On bigger tables, pocket openings look, feel and seem smaller, even though they're the same size, providing more of a challenge to competitive or advanced players.

Which Room Will the Table Be Placed In?

Will the room the pool table be placed in be used for other activities?

- Room will be used primarily for pool: Get the table that best fits the room size. Keep in mind the guides for room size are the minimum recommended sizes.
- A family room with plenty of space: Consider the skill level of the players to select the size. To add more family fun, get a table tennis top (for 7- and 8-foot tables)!
- The table will be used sparingly, located in a large game room or man cave (this is pretty common): Select a table that will easily fit the space available. Keep in mind that selecting a 9-foot table just because you have the space may not be the best choice. Typical players have more success and enjoyment on an 8-foot table.
- If you don't have a separate game room but do have a good-sized dining room, consider a dining room conversion pool table
- Do you have a good-sized deck or patio? Consider an outdoor pool table. This table comes with a dining top that converts to a table tennis top for even more game fun!

Regardless of which room you place the pool table in, it's ideal to let the table be the focus of the game play area. Don't have any other large pieces of furniture close by (like a sofa) that players will have to maneuver around. Keep the surrounding area clear of other clutter, like small plants or floor lamps that could get in the way of play.

Do You Have to Work Around Load-Bearing Supports?

If you have a load-bearing support pole/column in your room, the ideal table placement is to have the supports at the side of the table. If you have to locate it at an end, it is best to situate the table so that the pole is at the break end (vs. the foot or rack end) of your table.

Protect Your Table!

Regardless of what table size you decide to get, you should get a table cover to protect your investment from spills, people and pet hair or other mishaps.



What Table Size is Right for My Room?

We offer three sizes of pool tables so you can best customize your table to your space.

How Much Space Do You Have?

You might think "bigger is better," but it's better to have a bigger room with a smaller table, than a smaller room with a bigger table that cramps your playing style. When in doubt, opt for a smaller table.

The playing surface dimensions of 7 foot tables are 39" by 78". 8 foot tables 44" by 88". 9 foot tables 50" x 100". These dimensions are measuring from tip to tip of the gum rubber cushions.

The chart below gives you an idea of the *minimum* area required for each size table. Keep in mind that you need room for the table AND room for the cue length during play. If your desired table size doesn't quite fit, you can always play with shorter cues. We've provided specs for different cue lengths.



Premium Quality Pool Tables

Built Better to Play Better

All of our tables are built to tournament specifications, featuring 1-inch, 3-piece slate construction for the most accurate play. Each table is constructed from 100% solid hardwood. Support beams stabilize each table and ensure a solid, level playing surface.

Frame Construction

While other manufacturers cut corners with fiber or particle board in their frames, Spencer Marston tables use only high-quality hardwood for support beams. Speaking of beams, only the highest quality tables feature beams running the length of the frame, versus only crossbeams. The max-support dual beam construction includes two center beams to stabilize the frame and provide additional slate-leveling contact points.

Finally, each leg is attached to the table frame by threaded aluminum inserts, providing durable, precision assembly.






Rail Construction

The cushions are the most critical aspect of the rail system. Naturally, Spencer Marston wouldn't settle for anything less than cushions that meet or exceed regulation specifications set forth by the Billiard Congress of America for tournament-grade cushions, with a consistent nose height to maintain optimum performance and consistency in play.

The sub-rail (or rail liner) is invisible once the table is assembled. It's what the rubber is attached to and it's the part of the rail that comes in contact with the slate and allows the rails to be fastened to the slate. All our sub-rails are made of solid hardwood and have aluminum inserts at three locations in every rail, which allow for maximum torque on the connecting bolts, making the rails as tight as possible.

The rail caps on our tables are made of solid hardwood to enhance the furniture appeal of your table, and to stand up to potential abuse from cue scrapes. Each rail has three coats of high-density polyurethane for maximum protection and sheen. The benefit of solid wood is that it can be refinished if damage does occur over time.







Slate Construction

All our tables have 1" thick, three-piece slate. The Billiard Congress of America (BCA) requires that the slate on tournament tables be 1" thick, and all our tables have this 1" thick slate in three pieces. It will provide the truest and most accurate play, and is diamond-honed to within +/-.3mm.

A three-piece slate offers the best performance. With three matched pieces of slate, each can be leveled individually to achieve a perfect level.

Framed slate has an MDF liner attached directly to the bottom of each piece of slate. MDF provides a solid, secure location for stapling cloth, quiets the table and will not split or crack, which allows the table to be moved and reassembled repeatedly without damage.

Limited Lifetime Warranty

Each table is backed by a limited lifetime warranty. Spencer Marston quality and construction makes this possible.







Pool Table Shipping Policies

Shipping is Included in the pool table price for most continental U.S. locations. There might be an additional shipping charge for shipments to remote areas, islands or high-density metro areas that a semi-tractor trailer cannot access. Furniture purchased and shipping with a pool table is also shipped free of charge.

At our discretion, we may ship through any major moving companies.

NOTE: Installation is not included. If you are not an experienced pool table installer, we recommend White Glove Installation.

Tracking Your Order

PoolTables.com offers the fastest fulfillment time in the business—we are able to ship out most pool tables and accessories within five days of ordering. Our pool tables are packaged and handled with the utmost care.

Once your pool table order has been processed and the table leaves the warehouse, we'll send you an email with tracking and delivery information.

Please read that email as it will contain important delivery information as well.

Taking Delivery with White Glove Installation

If you've chosen White Glove Installation, this part is easy. We'll arrange for the pool table to be delivered to one of our approved installers in your area. After they've received the pool table and have inspected it to ensure nothing has been damaged in transit, they will contact you to arrange a delivery and installation date and time. You just need to be present for the installation and our experienced installer will handle the rest.

Taking Delivery with No Installation

- 1. The pool table will be delivered to your home in a semi-tractor trailer. Your home must have curbside access for a tractor/trailer that is 14' tall and up to 40' in length.
- You will be contacted by the shipper the day before delivery is to take place to establish a delivery time.
- 3. When the truck arrives, you are responsible for removing the pool table from the truck located curbside. You will need at least two adults as the table components weigh 1000 pounds with three heavy slates.

NOTE: If your home is not accessible by a truck of this size, you can arrange to pick up your pool table at a freight depot in your area. The table will fit in a full-size pickup truck. Please notify us if alternate delivery is needed.

Checking the Pool Table for Damage

After unloading the pool table components from the truck, you MUST check the boxes and crates for visible damage and sign the Bill of Lading (BOL).

If Everything Looks Good

If everything looks good, sign the Bill of Lading (BOL) that the pool table is FREE AND CLEAR OF DAMAGE. You are stating that you received your pool table in good condition.

If the Pool Table is Damaged

If the pool table is damaged in any way:

- 1. Accept the shipment but sign the Bill of Lading (BOL) as DAMAGED.
- 2. Contact us immediately.
- 3. Put everything in a safe area, and don't throw anything away, including boxes or crates.
- 4. Take pictures of the damage (damaged boxes/crates, or damaged products.
- 5. Submit the following to us within 24 hours:
- A copy of the signed BOL (can take a picture with your phone)
- Photos of packaging and damaged product(s)
- Description of the damage

We'll replace and expedite shipping of any and all damaged parts as soon as the documentation of damage is received.

P.S. Please don't be scared by all of this. Damage occurs in less than 1% of shipments. But if anything does happen, don't worry we'll take care of it!

If You Refuse an Order

If you refuse the delivery at your home, you will be responsible for:

- outgoing and return shipping
- a 15% restocking fee
- any installer handling fees (if you chose the White Glove Installation option).
